In honor of the late PGA Professional, Gene Siller, \$23,500 was distributed to 7 individuals and 1 organization looking to learn, play, and compete in junior golf initiatives. Recipients used funds for tournament entry fees, mental coaching, and competition travel.

The Grant's annual flagship pro-am fundraiser, the Red Pants Tournament, was held on August 14th at Pinetree Country Club. 115 golfers came out on one of the hottest days in Georgia history to raise \$91,000+. The event featured 18 holes, an online auction, complimentary food & beverage, gift bags, an awards reception, and speeches from the Grant recipients.

PGA HOPE GEORGIA AMBASSADOR SPOTLIGHT: ROBERT LEAHEY

Robert Leahey is a former Navy Corpsman who served 5 years with Marine Corps and Navy Expeditionary Units. Robert was first introduced to PGA HOPE during a speech about the program at the 2020 Ryder Cup Opening Ceremonies. He immediately returned home to Georgia and attended a Session at Bobby Jones Golf Course. Surrounded by fellow Veterans, compassionate PGA Professionals, and the therapeutic effects of golf- Robert felt right at home.

In the spring, Robert was nominated to be the 2023 PGA HOPE Georgia Ambassador. He now volunteers his time recruiting other Veterans to PGA HOPE and sharing the story of how PGA HOPE saved his life after the military. In October, Robert traveled to Congressional Golf Club in Washington D.C. for National Golf and Wellness Week to represent the Section and exchange ideas with other Ambassadors on how to improve PGA HOPE Georgia's offerings.

With Robert's help, PGA HOPE Georgia will expand its post program engagement next year, with a newly created Committee, to host an inaugural fundraiser event for the program and organize quarterly playing opportunities to bring Veterans back together.

CALAMITY JANE CHARITY CUP

The first annual Calamity Jane Charity Cup was held on October 12th at the Bobby Jones Golf Course. The event raised over \$36k benefitting PGA REACH Georgia and Bobby Jones Chiari & Syringomyelia Foundation. 18 holes of golf were followed by an awards ceremony, silent auction, and celebration at Fire Maker Brewing Taproom.

In partnership with the Atlanta Braves Foundation, PGA REACH Georgia hosted corporate foursomes at 4 of the most exclusive clubs in the country: Reynolds, Peachtree, Sea Island, and Atlanta Athletic Club. The initiative raised \$60k+ split evenly between the foundations.

PLAY YELLOW BIRDIE BASH

On April 22nd, Georgia PGA Professionals will play 72 holes at The Country Club of the South to benefit PGA REACH Georgia and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA). Working as a team of two in a scramble format, PGA Professionals will attempt to make as many birdies as possible with a goal of raising \$100,000 in one day. Prior to the inaugural event, PGA Professionals will peer to peer fundraise in order to solicit donations per birdie made throughout the day.

SMILING FORE LIFE

Smiling Fore Life provides young Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA) patients an outlet to escape the hardships they are facing and get out of the hospital room to enjoy a fun, new activity. Two Georgia PGA Members represent the Section each month by providing an hour and a half of basic golf instruction to a group of 5-10 patients at CHOA - Scottish Rite.

PGA HOPE CUP

The inaugural PGA HOPE Cup will take place at the 9 hole Bobby Jones Golf Course on Veterans Day, November 11th. All funds raised from the event will be matched up to \$10,000 and each Veteran will be announced on the first tee with their name and hometown.
